



Create a bird box

Spring has arrived and the birds are getting busy looking for a new home to raise their kids. Can you create a fun bird house for indoors? Great for storing cotton wool, or a small toy bird!

Materials

Empty tissue box (square), a piece of paper or card, Sellotape, colouring pens, safety scissors and a helpful adult.



1. Find an empty, square tissue box. Any brand will do!



2. Open carefully at one end and remove the plastic. Cut this plastic up and place in bin – let's stop wildlife from getting caught in the stuff, or worse, eating it.



3. Sellotape the open corners together to create a peaked roof.



4. Place a piece of paper or card on a flat surface, turn tissue box upside down and place in the middle. Mark with a pencil where the ends of the peaked roof meets the paper.



5. Bend the paper/card at these two points to create a roof top for your box.



6. Time to get creative, design your rooftop!



7. Place the roof on the tissue box and tape the roof to the sides of the box



8. Your house is now ready to be filled!

If you don't like the size of the roof it can be cut shorter.
