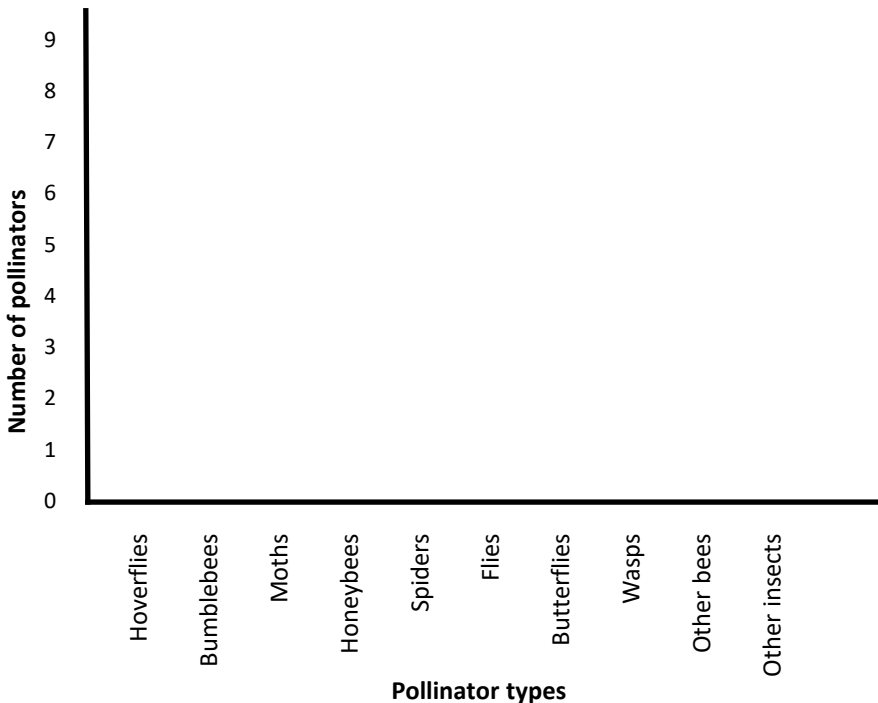

How many pollinators did you spot? Once you have completed your bug hunt fill in the table with the number of different pollinators you found.

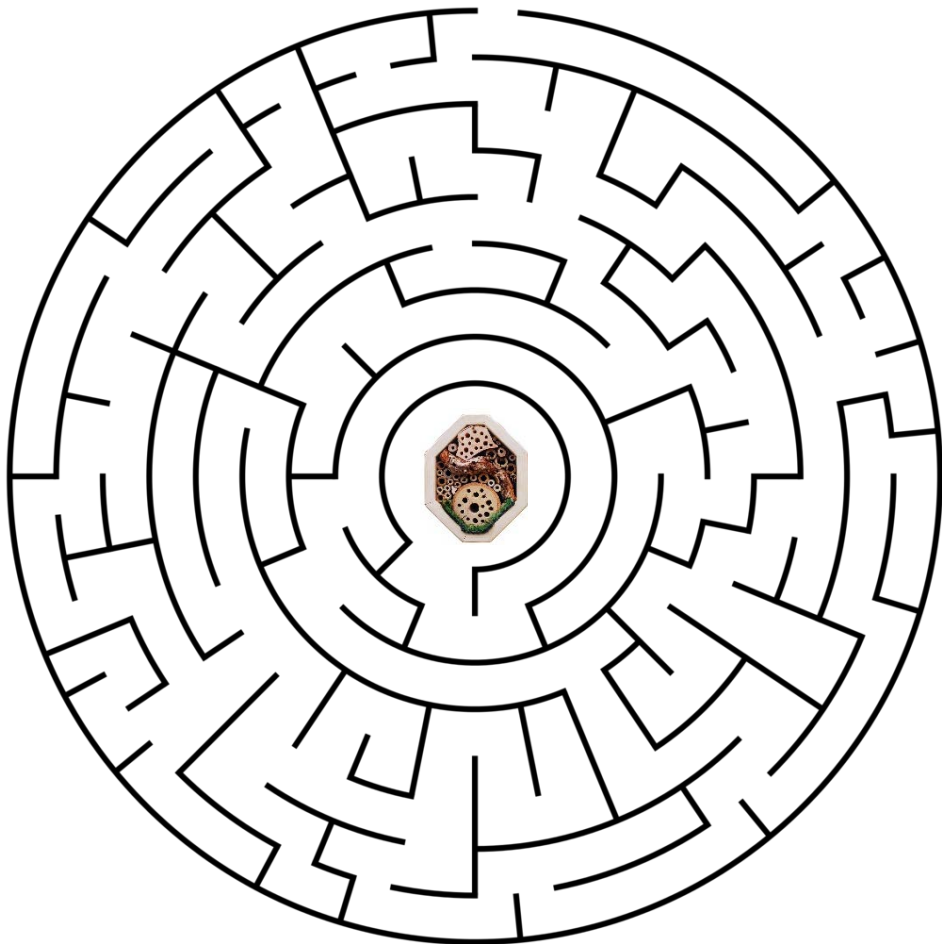

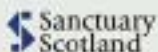
