Make a badger from loo roll

Pg 1

Materials you'll need

This is a great activity that will use up all of those empty toilet rolls.

A toilet roll inner Scissors and a responsible adult PVA/glue stick Paints/pens/pencils for decorating Card or paper –recycle an old cereal box!



Pg 2


Paws for a moment!

Time to colour cute little paws. Cut out the paws, ask an adult for help! These will stick onto the tummy area of the badger. Grey paws would look great against a black body and black paws against a grey body, which did you choose to do?



Putting it all together

You can colour the tummy grey or just leave it white. Cut out and glue under the face.



What do I do with them?

Take a loo roll inner and colour it in grey or black with paints/pens or pencils, Badgers have hair that starts off white, has a black or brown strip and then it ends in a white tip. This gives them the look of grey fur and helps blend into the forest floor at night.



Pg 3

All done

Finish up by sticking the tummy on the front. Can you imagine him scratching his tummy? You can now name your badger friend and add them to your collection
