

# Make a fox from loo roll



## Materials you'll need

This is a great activity that will use up all of those empty toilet rolls.

A toilet roll inner  
Scissors and a responsible adult  
PVA/glue stick  
Paints/pens/pencils for decorating  
Card or paper –recycle an old cereal box!

## What do I do with them?

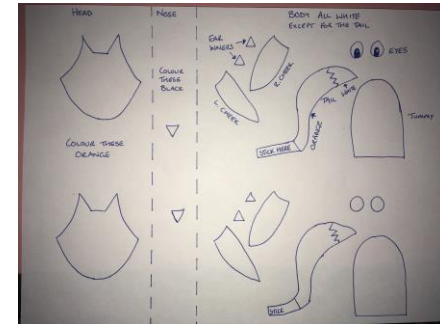
Take a loo roll inner and colour it in orange with paints/pens or pencils

Print page 2 of this activity on a separate sheet of paper and colour in, there are hints on which parts are coloured



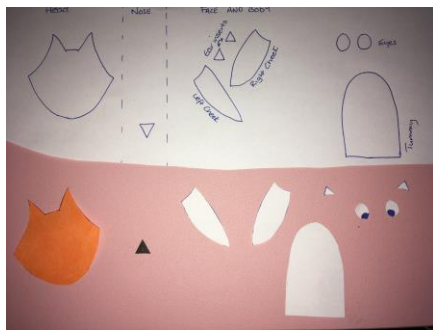

## Cut it out!

Time to cut out the fox, ask an adult for help! When cutting out the fox tail leave a little extra at the bottom to stick onto the roll.

## Putting it all together

Glue the backs of the cheeks and place them on the face first, glue the tummy section on and then the head above the tummy

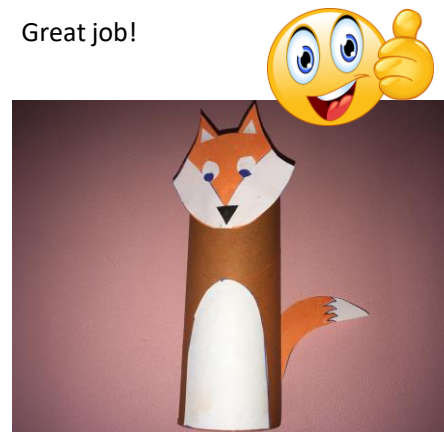

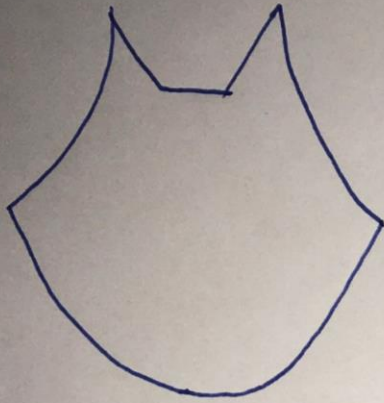

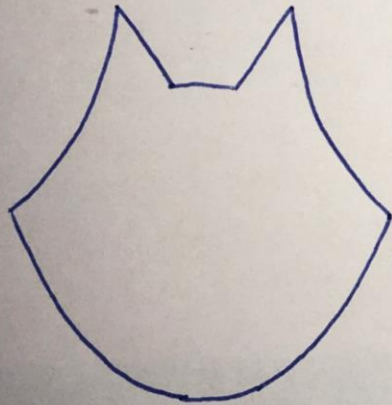
