



Crochet a 5 petaled flower

Start to bring all our flowers together with this new pattern by creating a simple small 5 petaled flower, suitable for a beginner to intermediate and is a great way to learn or practice a new stitch the half treble (htr).

- 3 mm crochet hook
- Any colour of DK yarn (double knit)

Crochet terms

ch – chain stitch dc – double crochet htr – half treble
 ss – slip stitch rep – repeat



Begin - Ch2 begin a start a magic circle, (2 Stitches)



Round 1. (dc into first chain), dc into next stitch*rep 5. ss into first stitch of round 1 (5 stitches)



Round 3. (ch 3, 2htr in to same stitch, ch 1, ss into next stitch)*rep 5



Finishing off. Pull ends tight and tie off leave ends for weaving into flower with yarn needle



Fantastic you have made your 5 petaled flower!
