

Make a hedgehog from loo roll

Materials you'll need

This is a great activity that will use up all of those empty toilet rolls.

A toilet roll inner
Scissors and a responsible adult
PVA/glue stick
Paints/pens/pencils for decorating
Card or paper –recycle an old cereal box!



Pg 2

What do I do with them?

Take a loo roll inner and colour it brown with paints/pens or pencils,

Hedgehog face

Copy or trace the face, or you could cut it out and stick it onto card to make it stronger, colour it in!



Pg 4

Paws for a moment!

Time to colour cute little paws. Copy the paws below onto the body of your hedgehog. Black paws would look great, what colour did you choose?



Pg 5

Putting it all together

Put a strip of double sided tape down the middle of the spines to stick to the body and colour in



Pg 6

All done

Finish up by sticking the spines on the back. Can you imagine him scratching his tummy? You can now name your hedgehog friend and add them to your collection
