

## Early connections Wild about Habitats

## Purpose

This document is a lesson plan for the Early Connections workshops series which connects children to nature through a mix of indoor and outdoor sessions. Workshops are aimed at children aged 8-12 years in P5-7and is a follow on from the Wild about Wildlife session. Wild about Habitats will discuss the wildlife in the town and where they live, examining habitats in the school grounds and learning about habitat fragmentation and animal extinctions. Each session is 45-60 minutes long.
