

Make a deer from loo roll



Pg 1

Materials you'll need

This is the easiest activity that will use up all of those empty toilet rolls.

A toilet roll inner
Responsible adult – Scissors
Tape or glue stick
Cereal box for card
Two awesome twigs
Paints/pens/pencils for decorating

What do I do with them?

Take a loo roll inner and colour it in reddish brown, it's summer time and the deer's hide is more red than brown! In winter it is a duller shade



Pg 3

Deer face

Bend in the tops of the toilet roll, this will help hold the twigs in place for the antlers – that is if you want to have a boy deer!
Girl deer's don't have antlers.

Larger deer face for colouring

Colour in!

Time to colour the deer's face, try using pencils as you will get much better colour and you will be able to add shade. We've used pen it is a bit dark!



Pg 6

Putting it all together

All that is left, is to cut out the deer's face. Position the face so that the ears of the deer cut out sit in front of the bent over loo roll

Great job!
